

## **GK Girls Booster Club Meeting Minutes**

5:35pm – Meeting called to order

The minutes from the Feb. 9, 2011 meeting were read. They were approved by Amanda Fox and seconded by Shana Passaro.

### **Treasury Report**

Frances announced that all 2010 and 2011 financial data has been entered into Quickbooks. Frances will create a Profit/Loss statement quarterly and can post it on the website. We have about \$3,700 balance right now with a few meet fee expenses expected for February. Frances passed around the income statements and charts.

### **Upcoming Meets**

All Level 3-6 gymnasts will be participating in the Critique Meet on April 16<sup>th</sup>. The question was asked if the Booster Club should pay for the \$30 registration fee for each gymnast. It was voted that each gymnast will be responsible for paying for their own critique meet fees in order to save booster club funding for “in-season” meets.

Debbie said that USAG is foregoing all Level 3 meet fees (at USAG sanctioned meets) this year in order to get more Level 3 teams competing. Our Level 3's still need to pay for the Critique Meet since this is not a USAG event, but just an Oceanside Gymnastics event.

The gym will also be holding a Mock Meet on May 14<sup>th</sup> for the Dynamites – Level 2 and the Rec kids. Team pictures will be on this day. We do not know who the photographer

will be at this time, but it is not going to be the same one as last year. The booster club will request that the gym do photos before the Mock Meet. The Level 4-7 girls will be performing during the Mock Meet.

## **Fundraising**

Our Panda Express dinner night raised approx \$140. Jennifer Wren passed out a flier with all of the fundraisers from March – June. The Spring See's Candy fundraiser order forms are now in each girl's file folder. All orders and money must be returned by April 1<sup>st</sup>. Are goal is to get \$2,000 in total sales. We will also have another dinner night on March 16<sup>th</sup> at Rubio's and Jen will collect recycling once a month at the gym. Our first recycling collection is March 23<sup>rd</sup> from 3:30-6:00. Drop off glass, cans, plastic, and Capri Sun pouches during this time.

In April, we will hold a raffle for Easter Baskets. The raffle will run April 1-22 and tickets are \$2 each or 3 for \$5. Amanda Fox is still looking for gift cards for ice cream, Boomers, movies, or other big ticket items to include in the baskets. We can do one boy and one girl basket, but if we get more donations we could make additional baskets to raffle.

We'll have two dinner nights in April – the 7<sup>th</sup> at Souplantation and the 26<sup>th</sup> at Shakeys. Our Team Social at Shakeys can also be a fundraiser if we choose.

Wendy Peterson did research on the Entertainment Coupon Books. We pick 40 coupons from local companies in up to 3 zip codes. We have to order 50 books and sell them at \$20 each. We make \$9 per book and an additional \$1 if we sell all books. It was mentioned that some schools are selling similar books for \$10.

In June, we'll have a dinner night at Famous Dave's. It'll run for three consecutive nights – June 13-15. We must have receipts totally \$500 and will get 25% back.

It was asked if we were going to have a Rummage Sale. Tami and Jen will work on setting a date for June.

Travis asked the gym about having a Cart-Wheel-A-Thon fundraiser for the girls to earn money for camp. The gym would like us to do it after a Friday night Open Gym because the coaches would already be here. It only took about 15 minutes to do last year. The fundraiser would be run through the gym so each girl could use her money earned for summer camp or for gym tuition costs. Travis will talk to Reevon and see if we could do the Cart-Wheel-A-Thon during the April 1<sup>st</sup> gym sleepover.

## **Camp Info**

Girls are attending camp at Woodward West June 19-25. Approx 20 families are interested. You can register online or contact Lenay Campbell at Woodward West. Debbie is going to send the camp a letter with all of the girls names and ages so they can room together. If your gymnast is going to camp, make sure to let Debbie know. The cost is \$825. The camp sent Debbie coupons for new campers for \$100 off camp fees. Contact Debbie if you want one of the coupons. If 10 or more girls go during the same week, one coach can go for free.

There is another camp in July at UCLA that some other families are looking at as well.
